	Date	Itinerary
01	10/18 Tues	Beijing <u>Miami to Beijing</u> Crossing the International Date Line you will lose one calendar day
02	10/19 Wed	<u>Arrive Beijing</u> Upon your arrival at the Beijing International Airport you will be met and transferred to the Westin Chaoyang Hotel. (Deluxe room)
03	10/20 Thurs	<u>Beijing</u> AB, L, D This morning, see vast <u>Tiananmen Square</u> and the extravagant Ming-era Imperial Palace in the <u>Forbidden City</u> , including the jewelry section. After lunch, visit the elegant <u>Summer Palace</u> , a UNESCO World Heritage site, with the largest imperial garden in the world. The grounds include over 3,000 structures with a variety of pavilions, towers and arched bridges surrounding Lake Kunming with boat ride (weather permitting). Tonight, attend a Beijing Duck dinner.
04	10/21 Fri	<u>Beijing</u> AB, L, D Today experience a highlight of your trip as you visit the renowned <u>Great Wall</u> . On the way, if traffic allows, stop to photograph the iconic "Bird's Nest"– the Beijing National Stadium–host to many spectacular events of the 2008 Summer Olympics. Then arrive at the amazing Great Wall, and walk along its ramparts as emperors once did. After lunch, visit a Cloisonné Factory and observe the skilled artisans at work as they create intricate designs. The rest of the afternoon is at leisure to shop.
05	10/22 Sat	Xian <u>Beijing to Xian</u> AB, D This morning, free at leisure. Perhaps shop for local bargains. Then fly to historic Xi'an, former capital of China. Hotel – Shangri-La Xian Hotel.
06	10/23 Sun	<u>Xian</u> AB, L, D A memorable day of sightseeing today as you view the extraordinary life-sized <u>Terra-Cotta army</u> , no two alike, buried for over 2200 years; Circle Vision Movie; Bronze Chariot and Xi'an City Wall.
07	10/24 Mon	Shanghai <u>Xian to Shanghai</u> AB Today, take a morning flight bound for cosmopolitan Shanghai. The balance of the day is free at leisure. Hotel – Renaissance Zhongshan Park (Deluxe room)
08	10/25 Tues	<u>Shanghai</u> AB, L, D <u>Sightsee</u> Shanghai's highlights: the Shanghai Museum with handheld <u>recorder</u> . The museum possesses more than 120,000 pieces of ancient Chinese art. Continue on to visit <u>Childre's Palace</u> or Urban Planning Center. Afterwards Visit Old Town Shanghai, Yu Garden and the city's colonial European past at The Bund, modern <u>Xintiandi</u> , and the Shanghai rug factory.
09	10/26 Wed	<u>Shanghai</u> AB, L, D Today you will enjoy a half day tour of Suzhou which <u>featues</u> a cruise of the Grand Canal, a visit to the Master of Fishing Nets Garden and if time permits a visit to Tiger Hill. You will return to <u>Shanghai</u> and spend the afternoon free at your leisure.
10	10/27 Thurs	<u>Shanghai / Miami</u> AB Departure transfer to the airport for flight home. Crossing the International Date Line you will arrive on the same day.
10	10/27 Thurs	<u>Shanghai to Hong Kong</u> Kowloon Shangri-La Hotel.
11	10/28 Fri	Hong Kong <u>Hong Kong</u> AB
12	10/29 Sat	<u>Hong Kong</u> AB
13	10/30 Sun	<u>Hong Kong to Miami</u>
